



WAYUMI COURSE ARRIVAL INFO

- **ARRIVAL:**

- We only do pickups from State College Airport (SCE) \$100
- If arriving by air, please send us your flight info.
- Please arrive on campus between 4:00 – 5:00 pm so we can get you settled before supper.
- A week before your arrival, you'll receive a cell number to text your ETA.
- The first meal will be served in the dining hall at 6:00 pm followed by an introductory session.
- The dining hall closes at 6:45 so that everyone can be present at the first meeting of the course at 7:00 p.m.

- **DIRECTIONS:**

- From Rt 220, turn at the traffic light onto Rt 287. Go one mile up Rt. 287 and take the first right, Old Forge Hill Road, crossing the cement bridge.
- South Rt 287, turn left onto Old Forge Hill Road, crossing the cement bridge. We are located about 3 miles past Salladasburg. You'll see our Ethnos360 sign as soon as you cross the cement bridge.
