- ♦ Choose Wayumi Quest/Date/your church name
- ♦ If your church name is not listed, please let us know.
- ♦ ALL INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATIONS ARE DUE ONE MONTH PRIOR TO ARRIVAL
- Arrange for transportation to and from Wayumi campus.
- Arrive between 4:00 5:00 p.m. so we can get you settled before supper.
- Inform students of our no-cell-phone policy

CHAPERONES

Ratio of 1 to 5, chaperone to student, per gender. (minimum: 2 adults per gender)

The actual guideline that we follow is a state law. We must have 2 chaperones in a room. If there are only 3 girls, we still need 2 chaperones in the room with them. So of course, this makes housing very tricky. Normally, this is not a problem, and we can work the housing/chaperone issues out. But this is also why we ask for individual registrations to be sent in as early as possible.

- Must have their clearances for working with minors.
- Be present with your students during the retreat.
- Be responsible for behavioral issues. (We aren't really expecting any \odot)
- Be responsible for known medical needs and to dispense medicines, as well as help with any emergencies that may arise, if necessary.
- Participate in the program & activities along with the students.
- Enjoy the retreat and have fun.
- Other accommodations available upon request for those coming in excess of the minimum chaperone requirement.



FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- A \$250 registration fee for the group is required after the Group Registration is received.
- The registration fee is applied toward the total fee.
- An invoice will be sent for the final balance which is due 10 days prior to arrival.
- The final balance is the total cost minus the paid registration fee.
- Payments can be made by check or online credit card payment.
 - ♦ Check is preferred, if possible, to save on credit card fees.
